IMPORTANT NOTICE

TO: All Licensed Adjusters

SUBJECT: Adjuster Renewal (August 1, 2017 - August 31, 2017)

DATE: June 1, 2017

Please be advised that it is time to renew your adjuster's license. To complete the renewal process, all licensed adjusters must complete an online renewal application and pay a licensing renewal fee.

ADJUSTER LICENSE FEES

The following fee schedule is applicable:

- The renewal license fee for all resident adjusters is \$80.
- The renewal license fee for all nonresident adjusters will depend on the **amount charged by your home state**, subject to an \$80.00 minimum. If your home state does not require licensure as an adjuster, then an \$80 license fee would be due. **Non-Resident adjusters are not required to submit a Letter of Certification.**

Examples of retaliatory fees are: North Carolina - \$230.00 Georgia - \$115.00

PENALTY PROVISION

South Carolina Code Section 38-47-40 provides that if the license fee is not received when due, the license must be canceled. However, if the adjuster license is canceled, a new application would be required, and payment of a penalty fee double the regular fee must be paid before the license can be reinstated. Therefore, if you allow your license to cancel, the following penalty fee would be applicable:

- A resident adjuster's **reinstatement fee** of \$80 would be due in addition to the \$80 renewal fee for a total of \$160.
- A nonresident adjuster's **reinstatement fee** would be double the retaliatory fee if in excess of \$80. Example, if your home state charges a \$100 fee for an adjuster's license, a \$100 penalty fee would be due in addition to the \$100 regular license fee for a total of \$200.

ADJUSTER RENEWAL INSTRUCTIONS ARE AS FOLLOWS:

Adjuster Renewal: Two Options for renewal will be available:

Renewal begins on August 1 and ends on August 31, 2017.

RENEWAL OPTION 1:

1. Go to the department’s home page (<http://doi.sc.gov>).
2. On the home page, click on “Online Services.”
3. Under the General Public heading click on “Renew/Reinstate Individual License.”
4. Scroll to the bottom of the Terms and Instructions page and click on “I Agree.”
5. Enter your SC license number, the last 4 digits of your social security number and date of birth.
6. Choose the License you are renewing.
7. Follow the instructions on the screen.
8. Select payment option.
9. Once the renewal is completed, a confirmation page will be displayed. Please print and keep this page as your receipt. You may also go back to our website to print out a new license with the updated renewal date.

Fees may be paid by electronic check, or by credit card. If paid by credit card, a \$1.43 processing fee and a \$1.00 portal fee will be added to the \$80 license renewal fee.

RENEWAL OPTION 2:

1. **Please do not attempt to renew on NIPR prior to August 1, 2017.**
2. Go online to renew at: www.nipr.com.
3. Follow NIPR’s online instructions.
4. Individuals renewing through NIPR must pay a \$5 renewal transaction fee in addition to the license fee.
5. Once the online renewal is completed, NIPR will send an email confirming that the renewal has been accepted. Please keep NIPR’s email as your receipt. Do not send verification to the Department.

TO CHECK THE STATUS OF YOUR RENEWAL, DO THE FOLLOWING:

1. Go to the Department’s home page (<http://doi.sc.gov>)
2. On the right side of the screen, click on the “**Online Services**” button.
3. Click Search SCDOI database.
4. Click Search for individuals.
5. Key in your license number OR your last and first name.
6. When the next screen displays, click on the individual’s name.
7. Scroll down to license type and click. Your renewal status will be reflected on the next page.
