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NOTICE OF LIQUOR LIABILITY DATA CALL

TO: All Insurers Licensed or Authorized to Write Property and Casualty Insurance Coverage in South Carolina

RE: Notice of Liquor Liability Data Call

This correspondence is being issued to provide notification of and guidance on reporting requirements relating to liquor liability insurance coverage in the State of South Carolina. In accordance with South Carolina Code of Laws Section 38-13-160, the South Carolina Department of Insurance is requiring all authorized property and casualty insurance companies, including licensed insurers and eligible surplus lines insurers, to complete the [attached spreadsheet](#) using only data related to liquor liability insurance coverage and return it to the Department. This notice does not apply to life or health insurers, monoline financial guaranty, mortgage guaranty, title, fidelity and surety, workers' compensation, or reinsurers.

Excel files of completed reports should be submitted via email to PCmail@doi.sc.gov by March 25, 2022. Please refer to the Instructions tab of the spreadsheet for further guidance relating to this data call. Any additional questions may be submitted to PCmail@doi.sc.gov.

If a company has multiple insurers within a holding company group, it will not be necessary to complete an Excel spreadsheet for each insurer. Instead, the holding company group should aggregate the information into one Excel spreadsheet and provide (on the Instructions tab) a list of those insurers within the group for which information is being aggregated.

The liquor liability insurance coverage data required under this data call must be submitted in Excel format. In accordance with Section 38-13-160, company responses must and will be treated as strictly confidential; responses will be aggregated for purposes of public disclosure.
